Purpose and objective of PACT meetings

The objective of this meeting is to provide an opportunity for members of the local community to raise their community priorities or concerns, receive crime prevention advice, and be updated as to what the police and partners have been doing to address the priorities and concerns raised at the previous meeting.

What communities raised at the last meeting - You Said:

- Church Street Park – nuisance bikes
- Horton Street / Wesley Street Junction - parking
- Southdale / Holy Trinity - School Parking

Actions Set at the last meeting:

Patrols to be conducted at the above locations and positive action taken as appropriate.

Actions Taken – We Did:

Since the last meeting we have:

- Carried out extra patrols on Towngate
- Held Community Contact Points in the Library & Town Hall.
- Visited Towngate School and talked with pupils
- Conducted a Licencing operation at RAYAN'S stores
- Conducted an immigration operation at am Ossett nail bar: 3 x Arrested, 1 x Deported, 2 x Civil orders
- Carried out a traffic Op on Kingsway: 1x Summons for use of mobile whilst driving, 1 x No insurance, Vehicle search drug dealing 1 x Arrest OPL, 1 x summons.
- Northfield Road – Street survey with residents
- ASB patrols have been carried out around Church Street and in Gawthorpe / Swithenbank
- A suspect for several commercial burglaries has identified and arrested.
- A suspect has been arrested for several theft from shop offences and a burglary
- Officers have spoken with Wakefield Council staff regarding damaged market stalls, no permanent damage.

New Public Concerns and Issues:

- Dewsbury Road & Towngate – Speeding & Quad bikes (Towngate)
- New Street - Vehicles going the wrong way down
- Station Road - Electric bikes
- Taxi parked on Marketplace outside Lady AJ'S
- Wesley Street - Parking

NPT Actions Set:

1. Speeding operation to be conducted on Towngate
2. Operation with Wakefield District Off-Road Bike Team – Towngate/ Station Road
3. Regular patrols to continue on Marketplace
4. Wesley Street – Local Councillors to liaise with relevant teams at WMDC.
